How often can I use the services?

Depending on the services offered, we distinguish between two different usage options:

Please note:

After using a mountain railway, the next mountain railway can only be used on the following day. However, it is possible to combine mountain railways, boat trips, and swimming on the same day, for example.

This rule applies to mountain railways, boat trips, swimming pools, and wellness facilities.

Dates and options for use can be found under the respective service. Some services can only be used once a week, e.g., e-bike rental.

Once per day – The service can be used once per day during your stay.

Once per week – If you are on vacation for longer than one week with the KÖNIGS CARD CARD, this service can be used a second time from the 8th night onwards, a third time from the 15th night onwards, and so on.

When is the KÖNIGSCARD valid?

The KÖNIGSCARD is valid from 12:00 noon on the day of arrival until 12:00 noon on the day of departure.



Allgäu

All of Bavaria's impressive royal castles — whether fairytale-like Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau or fortress-like Falkenstein, Freyberg, and Eisenberg — are located in the Ostallgäu region, the part of the Allgäu where the KÖNIGSCARD is at home.

It stretches from the rolling hills of the Alpine foothills to panoramic views of the Zugspitze and the sparkling lake landscape. The hiking and cycling region connects Lake Constance and Königssee.
